



What is a Donor-Advised Fund?

A Donor-Advised Fund is like a charitable checking account that serves as a hub for all your giving. One can establish a fund with cash, stock or other appreciated assets. You realize any tax benefits for which you qualify in the year of the donation. You can then recommend grants from your fund to the charitable organizations of your choice. In the meantime, any earnings in the fund are tax-free and available for grant recommendations.

How to Give From Your Existing Donor Advised Fund (DAF):

1. Contact your donor-advised fund (DAF) provider or log in to your DAF account online and request to recommend a grant to Thrive as the recipient organization. Provide the following information:
 - Organization Name: Thrive

 - Tax ID: 83-3540217
2. Specify the amount and frequency you wish to grant and include the purpose of the grant to say which Thrive staff or ministry team you want it to go to.
3. Submit the grant through your DAF provider and receive an end of the year grant acknowledgment letter from Thrive.
